Summary

The Maintenance Technician performs highly diversified duties in regards to the maintenance of the company grounds, building, production machines and other facility equipment.

Tools are not provided, must provide own tools necessary for this role.

Essential Functions

- Participates in the construction, installation, modification, maintenance and repair of electrical appliances, systems, facilities and related electronic controls and devices by interpreting blueprints, manufacturers' specifications and written and verbal instructions.
- Performs emergency/unscheduled repairs of shop production equipment in a timely manner.
- Perform regular preventative maintenance repairs of production equipment.
- Troubleshooting issues during the maintenance or repair of machinery.
- Diagnose problems, repair or replace parts, as well as test and make adjustments.
- Use a variety of hand and power tools, electric meters and material handling equipment in performing duties.
- Comply with all pertinent safety regulations.

Work Environment
